

Steps to Activate Your Personal MyChart Account

Step 1

- Go to: mountcarmelhealth.com/mychart
- Click the purple **Sign Up Now** button

Step 2

I DO have an Activation Code:

- Enter the Activation Code you received in the letter at your appointment check-in
- Enter date of birth using requested format (mm/dd/yyyy)
- Click on the **NEXT** button and proceed

Step 3

- Create a MyChart® ID
 - Must be 8 to 30 characters long and is not case sensitive
- Create a password (must be typed twice)
 - Must be different than your MyChart ID
 - Must be 8 to 30 characters long and is case sensitive
- Choose a security question and create a security answer

For your security and ease of use, select a MyChart ID and a Password that is easy for you to remember and impossible for anyone else to guess.

You will need to enter your MyChart ID and Password in the appropriate boxes (see Step 6 below) every time you access your MyChart account.

Note: Do not use your Activation Code as your MyChart ID.
