### Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS)

Advanced Cardiac Life Support courses teach physicians, nurses, respiratory therapists, pharmacists, and paramedic personnel how to apply current American Heart Association (AHA) guidelines for the delivery of emergency cardiopulmonary care.

#### ACLS for Less Experienced Personnel is a 1½ -day course, and you must attend both days.

ACLS for the Less Experienced Personnel course is designed for Health Care providers who have never attended an ACLS provider course OR are not comfortable with the ACLS content and skills, OR have an expired card.

**Prerequisite:** : Prior attendance at a Basic EKG course. You must have a current BLS (CPR-Health provider) card. Bring this card with you to the course. Your success in this course depends on your commitment to studying the material prior to the course. No handout materials will be given. It is expected that you will obtain a book, complete the precourse and self-assessment that is on the CD.

**Fee:** Physicians and dentists \$200.00; Residents and Medical students \$150.00  
Non Mount Carmel employees, Nurses, Nurse Practitioner and Physician Assistants \$100.00  
Mount Carmel employees \$15.00 (If not required on your unit)

### ACLS for More Experienced Personnel:

ACLS for the Experienced Personnel Course is a course designed for health care providers who utilize ACLS knowledge and skills in their daily practice and are familiar with emergency pharmacology, intubation, airway adjuncts, defibrillation and IV techniques. Experience includes being regularly and actively involved in patient resuscitation. A working knowledge of ACLS algorithms is needed.

**Prerequisite:** Must have a current ACLS Provider and BLS card (no grace period). Bring these cards with you to the course. It is expected that you will obtain a book, study and complete the precourse self-assessment that is on the CD.

**Fee:** Physicians and dentists \$150.00  
 Residents and Medical Students \$100.00  
 Non Mount Carmel employees (non-physicians) \$50.00  
 Mount Carmel employees \$15.00 (If not required for job)  
 There is no charge if ACLS is required for your job at MCHS.

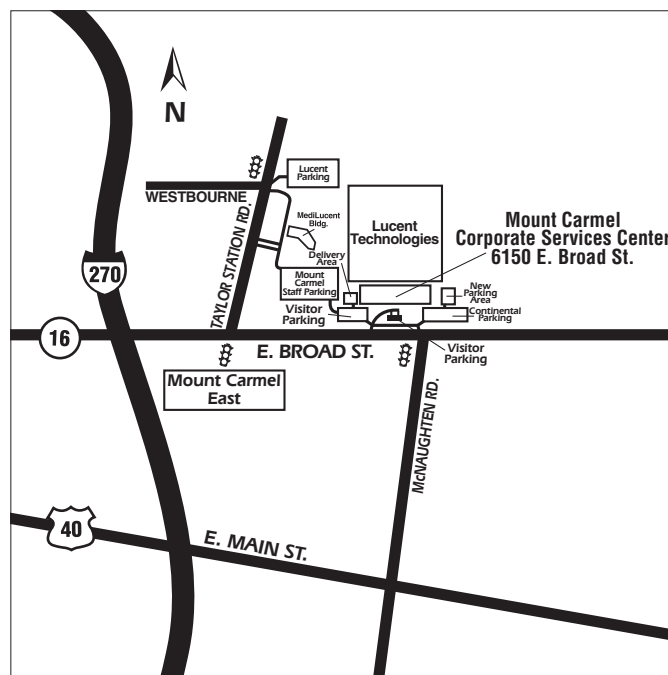

### E-ACLS: Skills for Megacode Testing

The E-Learning program for ACLS is available to non-expired ACLS card holders through the American Heart Association (AHA) website ([www.americanheart.org/cpr](http://www.americanheart.org/cpr); the cost is \$99). This self directed ACLS program provides an alternative training for the busy professional and is self-paced. Successful completion results in a certificate that needs to be taken to an authorized AHA training center for skills validation. The fee for skills validation is \$50.00. Note a Basic Life Support (CPR) Health Care Provider card is also required and should be brought to the skills check off. **Once you have completed the e-learning and obtained a certificate, you need to call Nelda Scriven at 614-546-3474 to schedule the specific date you are coming to complete your skills check off.**
