Mount Carmel offers a wide variety of American Heart Association courses. Basic Life Support (BLS) courses teach community members and healthcare professionals how to respond to a cardiopulmonary emergency by delivering care according to the current American Heart Association (AHA) guidelines. All courses will follow the new 2005 AHA guidelines and skill evaluation requirements. Each course is designed to meet the needs of a particular group or a job requirement. Below is a brief description for each course and the approximate class time needed to complete the material and hands-on participation.

Note: Not all courses listed in the brochure are offered on a routine basis. Please call 614-546-3473 to check for course availability. If a business or industry would like to have a class offered at their facility, please call 614-546-3473 for details.

HEALTHCARE PROVIDER COURSES

These courses are designed for those individuals who work in the healthcare field. Typically those who take the course are physicians, nurses, respiratory therapists, radiographers, physical and occupational therapists, paramedics and others who provide direct patient care. The course includes CPR skills for adults, children and infants, use of the Automated External Defibrillator (AED), and relief of foreign-body airway obstruction on adults, children and infants.

Healthcare Provider Training 4-5 hours \$55.00

For those individuals taking this level of training for the first time or whose Healthcare Provider card has expired. Participants are required to pass a written test and demonstrate the correct skills before a completion card is issued. Class number 1-6.

Healthcare Provider Renewal 4 hours \$40.00

For individuals who hold a current Healthcare Provider card and want to renew their card. Participants are required to pass a written test and demonstrate the correct skills before a completion card is issued. Class number 7-24.

BLS Skills Check-Off 30 minutes \$25.00

This is a skills check off only for those individuals who completed the on-line AHA training. Participants need to bring a copy of their certificate showing completion of the on-line training. Skills will be checked off any time between 8 a.m.- 3 p.m. during classes 1-30. If you are a non-employee, please call 546-3473 to schedule.

HEARTSAVER COURSES

These courses are designed for individuals who may be required to respond to life threatening emergencies such as: police officers, firefighters, security guards, teachers, and day care workers. Participants will learn how to recognize life-threatening emergencies including cardiac arrest and choking in adults, children and infants. They will also learn to recognize the warning signs of a heart attack and stroke in adults and respiratory emergencies with children.

Heartsaver CPR for Adult/Child 3 hours \$35.00

CPR and relief of foreign-body airway obstruction for adults or children (age 1-8). Participants must demonstrate correct skills before a completion card is issued. Please call 546-3473 if you are interested in this class.

Heartsaver CPR for Adult/Child and Infant 3-4 hours \$45.00

CPR and relief of foreign body airway obstruction for adults, children and infants. Participants must demonstrate the correct skills before a completion card is issued. Class number 25-30, 31-36, 49-54, 61-66.

Heartsaver AED 3-4 hours \$40.00 - \$55.00

Adult/child CPR, relief of foreign-body airway obstruction and use of an automated external defibrillator (AED). Infant CPR and choking can also be included in this training. Participants must demonstrate correct skills before a completion card is issued. Please call 546-3473 if you are interested in scheduling this class.

Heartsaver First Aid 7-8 hours \$70.00

Basic first aid principles and their application; how to recognize and respond to medical emergencies and specific steps for treating injuries. Also included are first aid for extreme heat, cold, bites, stings, adult CPR, relief of foreign-body airway obstruction, and use of an automated external defibrillator (AED). Participants are required to demonstrate correct skills before a completion card is issued. Please call 546-3473 if you are interested in scheduling this class.

This course can be divided into different components such as Adult First Aid only or Adult First Aid with Adult/Child CPR, and use of AED. (Infant CPR is optional). There is a separate Heartsaver Pediatric First Aid course. Please call 546-3473 for more details or if you are interested in scheduling any of these classes.

CPR FAMILY AND FRIENDS

This course is designed for laypersons who want to learn rescue skills for loved ones. It is appropriate for school children and for family members of patients at risk for sudden cardiac death. Information is presented about the AHA Chain of Survival, signs of cardiac arrest, heart attack, stroke and choking in adults and children. A written test is not required as part of this training.

CPR Family and Friends - Adult/Child and Infant 3-4 hours \$40.00

CPR for adult/child and infant; relief of foreign-body airway obstruction for each age group. A course participation card is issued. Class number 37-42, 55-60, 67-72.

CPR Family and Friends - Adult/Child 2.5 hours \$30.00

Adult/child CPR and relief of foreign-body airway obstruction. A course participation card is issued. Please call 546-3473 if you are interested in scheduling this class.

CPR Family and Friends - Infant 2 hours \$25.00

Infant CPR and relief of a foreign-body airway obstruction (newborn-1year). A course participation card is issued. Class number 43-48.

BLS INSTRUCTOR

BLS Instructor Course 1 day \$85.00

This course prepares individuals to teach Basic Life Support courses using the science, skills, and philosophy of the American Heart Association. Prerequisites: Current BLS Healthcare Provider card and complete an interview with BLS Faculty and/or coordinator. Mount Carmel employees must have completed a transfer request and interview process for Position 2.

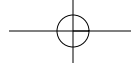
Participants will be required to purchase their own course materials.

BLS Instructor Renewal Course 4 hours \$75.00

This course is designed for current BLS instructors to review current practices, guidelines, and any updates from the American Heart Association or Training Center. Participants will need to complete the on-line E-bls Healthcare Provider renewal before coming to class. At the class instructors will be evaluated on their teaching skills and will need to complete their skills check-off.

Mount Carmel reserves the right to cancel any class due to low registration or emergency situation. In these circumstances the participant has the option of enrolling in another class or receiving a refund if a fee was paid.
