

## ***Jodi Wilson Named Site Administrator at Diley Ridge Medical Center***

Wilson most recently served as a consultant on nursing operations with a focus on emergency departments for healthcare clients across the county. She has also held leadership roles managing hospital emergency departments in Ohio and South Carolina.

"I am thrilled at the opportunity to lead Diley Ridge," Wilson said. There's a great need, and great anticipation, for medical and emergency services in northern Fairfield County. It's exciting to join such a vibrant and growing region, and we appreciate being welcomed so warmly in the community."

Wilson received a Bachelor of Science degree in nursing from Lourdes College in Sylvania, Ohio, and master's degree in business administration from the University of Findlay. She has also completed continuing education at Johns Hopkins Institute for Nurse Managers.

Diley Ridge Medical Center includes a 24-hour emergency care center staffed by emergency medicine physicians, emergency-trained nurses, ER technicians, and support associates, with access to ground and air transport services. The facility will offer imaging services such as MRI, CT scan, x-ray, ultrasound, and mammography, as well as a clinical pharmacy and laboratory. Diley Ridge Medical Center will also include a 46,000 square-foot medical office building for specialty and primary-care physicians, and a Nationwide Children's Hospital *Close To Home*<sup>SM</sup> Center featuring urgent care. Diley Ridge is on schedule to open in winter 2010. Future plans for Diley Ridge could include outpatient surgery and a full service hospital as the population grows.
