

GET INVOLVED: Mount Carmel Volunteer Services



WE NEED YOU!

Do you have a few hours to spare each week? Are you interested in giving back to your community? Are you a retiree and want to share your knowledge and experience? Are you new to the community and would like to meet people? If you answered **yes** to any of these questions...we need you.

Volunteers serve one day per week, for a four-hour shift, and serve a maximum of 10 hours per week. Shifts are available Monday through Friday, with limited weekend availability. Volunteers maintain the same shift time each week, for easy schedule planning.

Frequently Asked Questions

Do I have to wear a uniform?

All volunteers follow the uniform requirements including a name badge and a red volunteer top. Embroidered polo shirts, vests or jackets may be purchased for \$20 and should be worn with khaki or black pants.

Can I switch volunteer roles or shifts?

Yes! Volunteers can shadow other roles to see what might work best for them or change their shift time.

How do I take time off?

We know volunteers may need time away due to sickness, travel, or personal matters. Just let us know ahead of time. Need to be gone for a longer period of time? Volunteers can take a six month "leave of absence" as needed.

Can I volunteer with a friend/spouse?

We welcome individuals who want to volunteer together. We can offer roles that allow you to volunteer as a team or simply schedule you for the same shift time.

Getting Started



1. Complete an online application at **www.mountcarmelhealth.com/volunteering**. Select the application for the hospital where you would like to serve.
2. Once your application is reviewed, you may be contacted for an interview.
3. Prospective volunteers will be asked to complete a background check or fingerprinting.
4. All new volunteers are required to complete a TB test prior to serving in the hospital.
5. Volunteers may be required to receive a flu shot or complete a declination.
6. Volunteers may be asked to provide COVID vaccination status or complete a declination form.
7. Volunteers interested in certain roles will be required to complete a physical.
8. All new volunteers complete an orientation and are trained on their specific volunteer role.
